Certification comes on the heels of VA Verification of SDVOSB Status.

Belleville, Illinois, September 5th, 2008: The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) today formally notified the Veteran Corps of America that the company has been certified to participate in SBA's 8(a) Business Development Program. In conjunction with becoming an 8(a) program participant, SBA also certified Veteran Corps as a Small Disadvantaged Business (SDB). These certifications by SBA are effective until September 5, 2017. Veteran Corps' status as a Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business (SDVOSB) was also recently confirmed by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Center for Veterans Enterprise under the auspices of the VA's recently enacted veteran owned business verification program.

Veteran Corps president, Bill Wheeler, is a former U.S. Air Force officer who was medically retired as a cumulative result of injuries he received while on active duty. "One of the single biggest steps faced by our wounded warriors during their rehabilitation is reentering the workforce and earning a paycheck again. The 8(a) Business Development Program will serve as a force multiplier in terms of our opportunities for growth and our ability to help veterans help themselves" said Wheeler.
